The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

- 1. "School will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the middle classes".
- 2. The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the Board upto Classes X vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009 in the school.
- The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State Govt./UT.
- 4. The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
- 5. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under:-

Failure to do so will lead to suo moto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for secondary Examination granted by the Board.
- 6. The school should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
- 7. The school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
- 8. Service conditions, pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be at least at par with that of corresponding categories of employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
- 9. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.
- 10. The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodations i.e. Rooms, Halls, etc. available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charges if required.
- 11. The school will spare sufficient teachers, for invigilation purpose at the examinations of the Board, as may be required.
- 12. The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of answer-books for the Board's examinations, if required.
- 13. The school will provide Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.
- 14. The school will abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.

- 15. The school should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers or computer student ratio of 1:20 and proper software alongwith facility of Broad Band Connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider.
- 16. The school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'persons with disabilities act -1995'.
- 17. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.

- 24. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 25. Annual fee of ₹ 4500/- @ ₹ 1500/- per annum for three years (01.04.2012 to 31.03.2015) be also remitted at an early date. (In case of overseas Independent school @ ₹ 5000/- p.a. and overseas Kendriya Vidyalayas @ ₹ 3500/- p.a.)

- (b) Elective Subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics, Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Geography, History, Home Science, Informatics Prac., Painting, Physical Education, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology.

Since the Upgradation has been granted without inspection as per Circular No.6 issued on 22/01/2013, the school is likely to be inspected at any time in future to confirm its suitability including labs, teaching staff and other requirement required for Senior Secondary Level School

The sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions in addition to the general conditions intimated at the time of grant of provisional affiliation for secondary classes:

- "The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Senior 1. School Certificate Examination and changes made therein from time to time."
- The school will implement Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) as per the schemes of the 2. Board upto Classes X.

Further, **Service contract** will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.
- 23. Pay and allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government/Govt. of India. Further, Salary and Service conditions of staff should be provided in accordance with Rule no. 3.3 (v) and Rule no. 10.2 as appended below:
 - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.
 - b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.
- As per Rule 13.3 and 13.3 (i), the school shall supply information and returns called for by the Board/State/ Central Government/Local Authority within the prescribed time given for its furnishing to the authority concerned and the school should prepare its annual report containing comprehensive information including name, postal address and e-mail, telephone numbers, affiliation status, period of provisional affiliation, details of infrastructures, details of teachers, number of students and status of fulfillment of norms of affiliation Bye-Laws and upload the same on the website before 15th September of every year. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, postal address and e-mail, telephone number etc.
- 25. Continuous **sponsoring of students at Board examination** is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv), Failure to do so will lead to suomoto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for Secondary and Senior Secondary Examination as the case may be.
- 26. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.
- 27. Running of classes of **coaching institutions** in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 28. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disabilities Act 1995'.
- 29. School infrastructure and teachers for examinations conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
- 30. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least **one week training programme** for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
- 31. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a **Health Wellness teacher** as per rule 53.5.
- 32. Strict adherence to the provisions of **Wild Life Protection Act** while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
- As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books published by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of **private publishers**. The contents must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If prescribed books found having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.

- As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 53.2.2(a) and 53.3, a teacher appointed to teach Class I to V and VI to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/ State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.
- 35. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee (Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV).
- 36. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 37. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
- 38. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
- The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites www.cbseaff.nic.in&www.cbse.nic.in for updates.
- 40. In case of established violation of the provisions contained in Affiliation/Examination Bye laws of the Board, the school shall be liable for disaffiliation as per Rule No. 17 of Affiliation Bye-laws.
- 41. The school shall enter into an agreement with the Board detailing the terms and conditions for grant of affiliation, which will be binding on both the parties.
- 42. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-
 - (a) The School Managing Committee does not have Board's nominee. The school is required to forward a panel of 5-6 Principals of Senior Secondary School affiliated with the Board (at least 2 Principals from J.N.V. /K.V.) for approval of CBSE's nominees in the School Managing Committee as per Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board.
 - (b) The school is required to appoint more trained and qualified PRTs & TGTs to maintain section-teacher ratio as per norms and furnish a fresh staff statement accordingly.
 - (c) There are a few teachers **untrained** whereas the school is required to appoint only trained and qualified teachers as per norms of the Board.
 - (d) Number of books in the library is not as per Affiliation Bye-laws. As per norms there should be at least five books per child in the school library excluding text books, magazines, dailies etc.
 - (e) The school is required to maintain the amount of FDR as per the strength of students in the joint names of Secretary, CBSE and Manager of the school as per provisions of Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board.
 - (f) The school is required to furnish an affidavit in original sworn in before the first class magistrate to the effect that the school is not sponsoring candidates of any other school/Board in the Board examination.
 - (g) As per Rule No. 7.2 of Affiliation Bye-Laws, the accounts of school should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy of each of the Statement of Accounts should be sent to the Board every year. Hence, the school is required to submit Audited Account Statements as per norms.
